U.S. unemployment in November 2011 was 8.6%. That's 13.3 million people who were out of work and looking. It does not include those who had given up, the 15.6% who are underemployed, or those fearful that they will soon lose their job. Around 5.7 million have been out of work for 27 weeks or more, and only 13 percent of them are currently collecting unemployment benefits. The average length of unemployment in Michigan is 39 weeks.

Of the long-term unemployed and underemployed, 51 percent say they have borrowed from friends or family to get by. Close to half have trouble paying for housing and food. Additionally, 9 percent have lost their home to foreclosure. Kiplinger anticipates that the U.S. Economy will grow around 2% in 2012, about the same as in 2011, and not enough to make much of a dent in unemployment. All this suggests that at least 10 to 15 percent of the people in your church need help finding a job.
